

RESOLUTION NO. 25-11
HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHER PAYMENT STANDARD

The following Resolution was introduced by Chairperson Wahlstrom:

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires public housing authorities (PHAs) which administer a Housing Choice Voucher program (HCV) to establish payment standards which are used to calculate housing assistance payments (HAP) that the PHA pays to landlords/owners on behalf of participant families leasing an HCV unit; and

WHEREAS, the range of payment standard amounts is to be based on HUDs published Fair Market Rent (FMR) schedule for the federal fiscal year for the FMR area in which the HACD has jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, HUD’s final FY2025 FMRs for DeKalb County Illinois have been publish and HACD will set its payment standard amounts within the HUD allowable range of 90% to 110% of the most current published FMR rates; and

WHEREAS, modifying the existing Payment Standard Schedule as presented will help to maintain, or grow the current level of families served while encouraging participation for both current and prospective landlords/owners; and

WHEREAS staff has analyzed the Authority’s current Housing Choice Voucher payment standards and recommend that the current payment standards be modified as follows:
